The year 2008 brought about all the routine duties of a fire department. Spring of this year the Department performed hose test on the entire department's fire hose. All defective hoses were taken out of service. Fire school in Grand Island, Nebraska was attended this spring with eight members attending the three days of classes.

This year the department purchased new pagers, bunker gear, LD hose, nozzles, Electric positive pressure fan and a thermal imaging camera.

All equipment owned by the fire department is in good working condition. Burn permits were issued again this year to all people wishing to do open burning in our fire district.

Current membership of the Wahoo Fire Department is now 36 members, which includes 2 new members this year.
