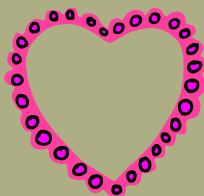

Trustees Update

The Library Board of Trustees recently completed a strategic plan for the library. The board created a community survey and over 175 were returned. Overall the responses were favorable to the library services and staff. One major discovery from this survey was the number of people who use the library for computer use. Over 48% of the respondents felt that computer use was important. Just from library statistics, we currently average over 1000 computer uses per month. Fiscal year 2007/2008 showed that 11,579 patrons used library computers or about 965 users monthly.

Due to increased activity on the online card catalog computers, we noticed that many were unhappy with the speed of these computers. With that in mind, we recently asked the Wahoo Library Friends to earmark the money raised at this month's Wine & Dine fundraiser for new online catalog computers. This should address the speed problem and make using the online catalog a more pleasant experience.

We appreciate all who completed surveys and we will continue to address some of the other areas that we discovered with the surveys.
