A ground-breaking work, it has been called “as near to a new fiction form as you could get.” The Nebraska Center for the Book board selected this book for Nebraska’s statewide read to celebrate the 100th anniversary of the birth of Wright Morris. Morris is regarded as one of America’s most gifted novelists and photographers.
