 - Online card catalog—you can renew books and put books on hold, all from the comfort of your home. Just ask the librarians to set up a password for you.

The library also:

- Offers access to over 200 DVD's—including many 'classics'
- Offers access to over 500 audio-books—no more boring commutes
- Subscribes to 5 local newspapers—Omaha World Herald, Lincoln Journal Star, Fremont Tribune, Wahoo Newspaper and Midlands Business Journal. We also get the USA Today Newspaper

- Offers computer classes for a very small fee with one on one learning
