The mural celebrates and shows the first Wahoo Public Library moving into the City Hall in 1923. The 6'X10' canvas painting will hang on the north

wall of the meeting room.

Also being showcased will be photography of Wahoo and Saunders County taken by Rob Liliedahl, a former Wahoo resident. These photos will be on the west wall on the meeting room art space.
