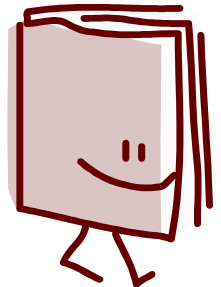
June and July's books are available now—just check at the front desk. Our August selection will be available at the July meeting.

Upcoming Friends of the Library Events!

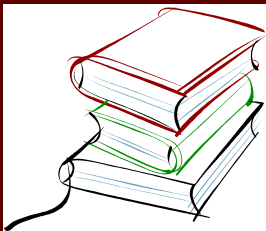
During the Saunders County Fair the Friends of the Library will be helping to staff a booth at the Saunders County Fair—make sure to stop by and check it out!
