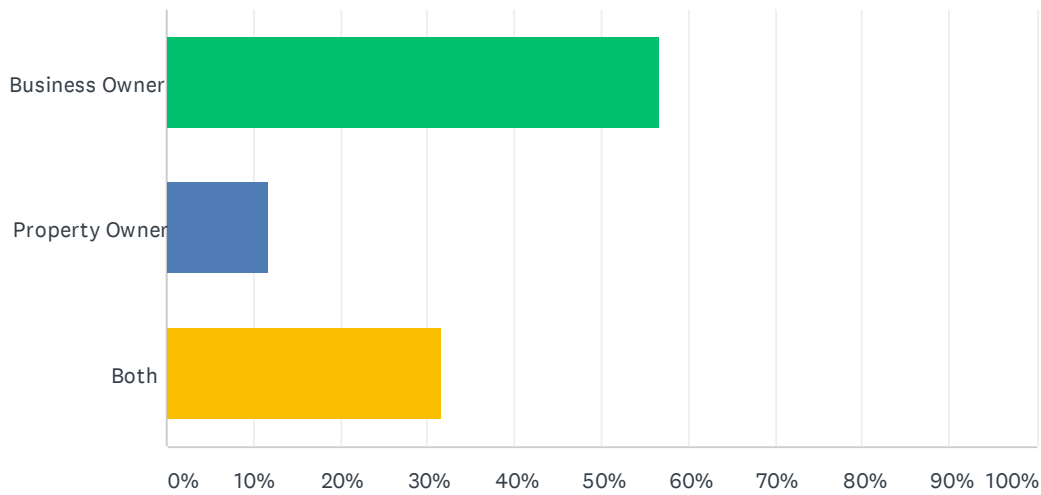


Q1 What is your role in Downtown Wahoo?

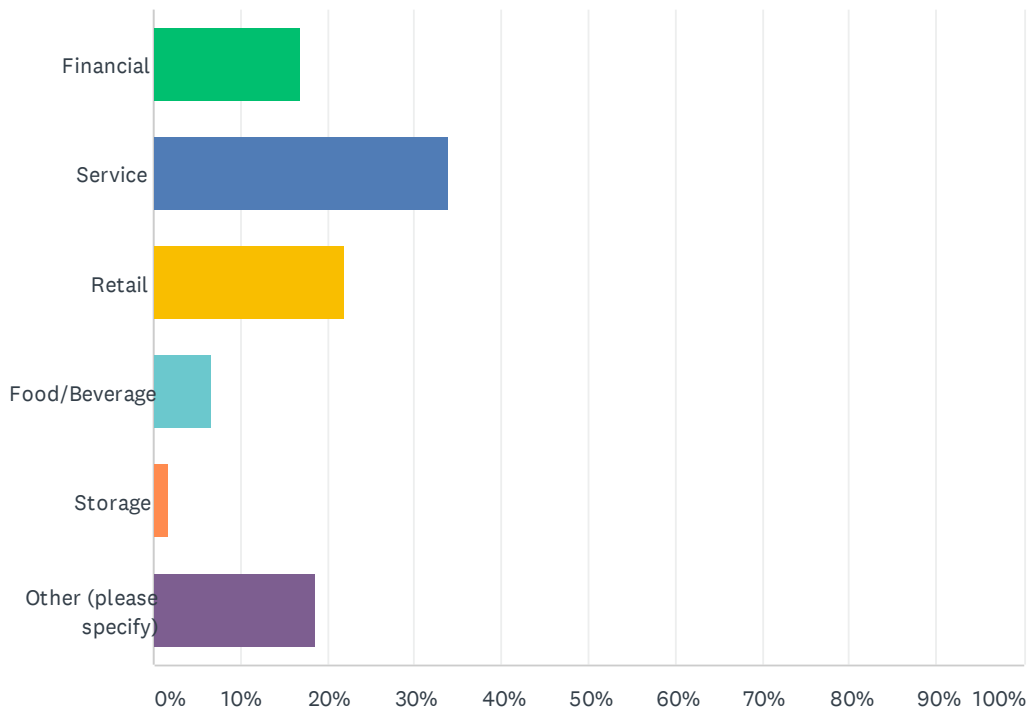

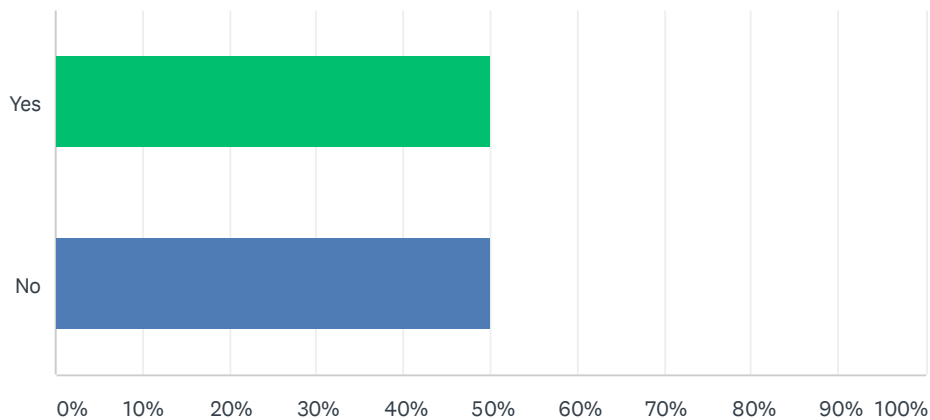

Q7 If you have a residential property, do you have enough off-street parking available for your residents?

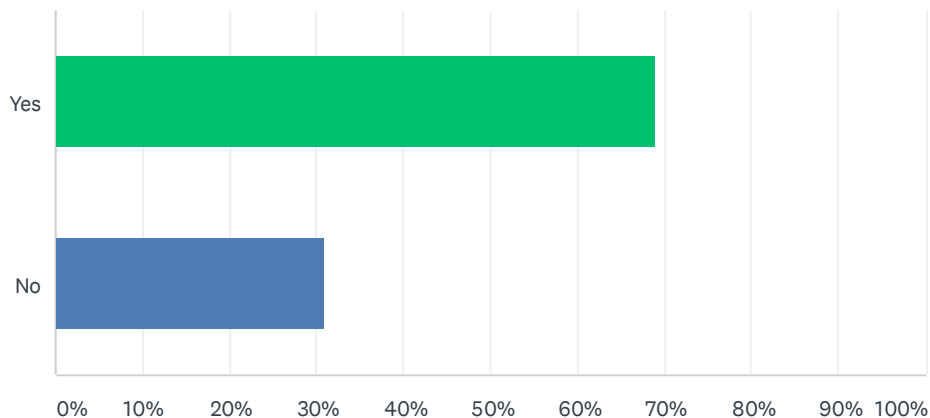

Q8 Residential property currently exists along Broadway and 5th St. Should residents be allowed to park in front of their residences overnight?

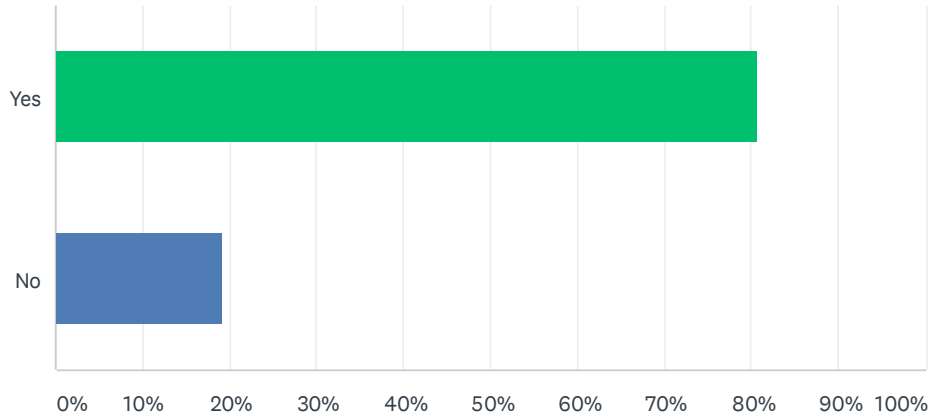
